**Welcome to Christ Church.** As you prepare for worship today, we invite you to offer a prayer, quietly greet a friend, or listen to the musical prelude.

### **Worship Books**

We use three books in worship. The abbreviations for these books are BCP (red Book of Common Prayer), Hymnal (blue 1982 Episcopal Hymnal), WLP (green Wonder, Love, and Praise paperback hymnal). The blue 1982 Hymnal includes both sung service music and hymns. The service music is at the beginning of the hymnal and is noted with an “S” in front of the number.

### **Stand, sit, or kneel?**

We adopt a variety of body postures to aid worship and invite you to join us as you desire. We stand to praise, proclaim, and sing. We sit to listen. We kneel to contemplate and to confess. Suggestions for worship are listed in italics. You may notice people using gestures in worship and prayer, you are welcome to join them if you wish. Please feel free to adopt the body posture and gestures of your home tradition.

### **Communion**

Communion is the table of the Lord. Christ is the host. We are all guests. We are all welcome to eat and be nourished, fed, and forgiven. Come and eat and live!

At the sharing of the Eucharist, we form two lines and come forward to receive communion. The two lines take turns to receive the bread. Gluten free wafers are available. Pick up a small glass to receive the wine from the chalice or cruet, depositing your glass on the gold platter at the end of the rail. You are invited to say, “Amen” after receiving the bread and the wine. If you prefer a blessing or do not wish to receive the wine, please cross your arms over your chest when you approach the rail. Please alert someone sitting near you if you desire communion served to you in the pew. You may wish to kneel for prayer before or after receiving communion.
